Policy Number: PL 006

Subject: Applications for Advanced Tradesman licence

Effective Date: 1 August 2010

Revised: 8 December 2014

The *Plumbers & Drainers Licensing Act* states that, to qualify for an Advanced Tradesman's licence, an applicant must demonstrate that he/she is competent to:

- (i) *assess the scope and technical requirements of plumbing or draining under a contract; and*
- (ii) *determine the skills necessary to carry out the work; and*
- (iii) *put in place appropriate arrangements for carrying out the work properly and safely in compliance with the prescribed Acts.*

The Plumbers & Drainers Licensing Board has determined that, in order to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of the Act, applicants must provide evidence to show that they have:

1. Completed two years post-trade work experience in plumbing/draining from the date of issue of unconditional Journeyman Registration Card in Australia;
and
2. Completed the following 10 units of competency from the Certificate IV in Plumbing and Services.

Plan size & lay out hot & cold water services

Commission & maintain hot water temperature control devices

SANITARY

BCPSN4001A

Plan size & lay out sanitary pipework & fixtures

DRAINAGE

BCPDR4001A

Plan size & lay out sanitary drainage systems

BCPDR4002A

Plan size & lay out stormwater drainage systems

BCPDR4003A

Design domestic treatment plant disposal systems

MUTUAL RECOGNITION

*An applicant who holds a **current** Registration or Licence in another state/territory may apply for the equivalent in the NT under Mutual Recognition. Evidence of the current licence or registration must be provided with the application.*
