USING YOUR NT CARD IN OTHER STATES

Your NT registration or licence card is only valid for work in the Northern Territory. However, provided it is **current**, you can use your NT registration/licence to apply in other states under Mutual Recognition and the Board in that state will give you their equivalent of what you have in the NT.

Please note – in the NT a registration or licence is issued **only** in the categories of **Plumbing and Draining**. An application for registration/licence in another state under Mutual Recognition will give you only those categories. In other states you may need to be registered to undertake other work (eg roofing), which in the NT does not require a licence.

If, during your apprenticeship, you completed other categories (eg Roof Plumbing, Mechanical Services) you may be eligible for registration/licence in those categories in other states, but you will need to apply for these separately from Mutual Recognition and provide evidence that you completed the relevant study units during your apprenticeship. Evidence would be the list of results provided by Charles Darwin University with your Certificate of Completion.

You should discuss this with the interstate licensing board when you lodge your application.
