

# Plumbers and Drainers Licensing Board



## OVERSEAS TRAINED PLUMBER/DRAINER

### **Who can work as a plumber/drainer in the NT?**

Only someone who holds a NT plumbers/drainers licence or registration. Interstate licences are not valid in the NT.

### **What is the difference between registration and a licence?**

A **Journeyman** registration allows you to work as a plumber, employed by and under the supervision of a licensed tradesman.

An **Advanced Tradesman** licence allows you to contract for work, employ others, carry out plumbing or draining work.

### **How do you get Journeyman registration?**

Complete an apprenticeship and a Certificate III in Plumbing.

### **How do you get a licence?**

Hold Journeyman registration for 2 years while working as a plumber **and** complete 10 Cert IV competencies.

### **What if I did my apprenticeship overseas?**

You must prove you also have a Certificate III in Plumbing from an Australian Registered Training Organisation (RTO) **and** 12 months work experience in the NT plumbing industry, certified by a licensed tradesman.

### **How do I get a Certificate III?**

By completing gap training with an RTO in the NT.

### **Can I work to gain experience while I do gap training?**

If you have a Certificate III from an Australian RTO, or you have signed up for gap training with a NT RTO, the Board will grant you Conditional Journeyman registration. This allows you to work as a plumber.

### **What is conditional registration?**

Conditional registration allows you to work to gain practical experience while completing the gap training required for a Certificate III.

### **How do I get conditional registration?**

Apply to the Board with:

- Application Fee,
- Evidence of overseas apprenticeship,
- Evidence of experience, and
- Evidence of either a Certificate III or enrolment in gap training at a NT RTO.

### **What are the conditions?**

- Conditional registration cannot be used to get registration elsewhere.
- You must be employed by and work under the supervision of an Advanced Tradesman.
- You must make significant progress in gap training.

### **How long is it valid for?**

Three months with the possibility of extension.

### **Will it be extended?**

If you make significant progress in gap training the Board may approve an extension, on request.

### **Is there a limit on extensions?**

For an extension beyond 12 months, you will need written evidence from the RTO that you have made significant progress in gap training and that non-completion is not your fault.

### **What happens after gap training is complete?**

The RTO will issue you with a Certificate III.

### **What do I do then?**

Apply for Journeyman Registration.
